## How to Pray The Chaplet of Divine Mercy

1. Make the Sign of the Cross
2. (Optional\*) Pray,  
You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.
3. "Our Father,"  
Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil. Amen.
4. On the Our Father beads pray,  
Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.
5. On the Hail Mary Beads pray,  
For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
6. Pray three times,  
Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

Close with the Sign of the Cross.  
Jesus' promise to St. Faustina:  
"Say unceasingly this chaplet that I have taught you. Anyone who says it will receive great Mercy at the hour of death. Priests will recommend it to sinners as the last hope. Even the most hardened sinner, if he recites this Chaplet even once, will receive grace from My Infinite Mercy. I want the whole world to know My Infinite Mercy. I want to give unimaginable graces to those who trust in My Mercy..."  
"...When they say this Chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My Father and the dying person not as the just judge but as the Merciful Savior."

COVID CONSULTATION: It is being proposed to cease the one-way entrance to and exit from the church (currently entering through the South Door and exiting through the West Door). It is felt that there is hardly a large crowd at Mass and that therefore people can be trusted to be sensible in not squeezing too closely together when exiting the church. At the same time, it is proposed to return to having Mass at the Main Altar and resuming having a server at Mass when one is available. Those who prefer to maintain more social distancing currently sit in the side aisles. The proposal would be that they would be able to sit in the chancel choir stalls. Holy Communion would be given to them first, and then to the people from the point where the temporary altar currently stands.
